



WORLD ASSOCIATION PIN

Girl Scouts was founded in 1912 by Juliet "Daisy" Low based on Lord Baden-Powell's Scouts in Britain.

The World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) includes girls in scouting all over the world.

On May 9, 1991, the World Association introduced a new design for the World Pin and the World Flag. Created forty-five years ago, the original trefoil logo symbolized the threefold Promise all members make on joining the Girl Guide / Girl Scout movement. This symbolism is continued in the new trefoil design, each element of which has specific meaning.

The golden yellow trefoil on a bright blue background represents the sun shining over the children of the world.

The base of the stalk is a reminder of the flame of the love of humanity. The upward pointing vein represents a compass needle pointing the way.

The two stars placed inside the trefoil illustrate the Promise and Law, the basic philosophy of all Girl Guides and Girl Scouts.

The flowing line encircling the trefoil depicts our worldwide movement.
